In the meantime, we have some blue and white fabric left over due to members' generous donations, and are in the perfect position to use it to make comfort quilts. We thought it might be fun to incorporate social events into the creation of the after quilts!

Please look over the following information and let us know if you would like to participate! After Quilts Kits will be available until we run out at future meetings or by making arrangements for pickup.

Workshops and /or smaller pod meetings at peoples homes will be scheduled in the future depending on interest. Everything will be posted on the website.

OPTIONS FOR PARTICIPATION:

BLOCKS

Make a 12 1/2 inch square block in any pattern or technique you choose with the fabric provided. Feel free to add your own blues or whites to amplify what is what is in your kit. Blocks made in this category will eventually become a sampler quilt.

OR Make a set of 4 Hunter's Square Block 8" blocks on your own or in a larger workshop or smaller pod setting. Blocks made in this category will eventually become a hunters star quilt or the center of a scrap quilt depending on how many are made.

QUILTING

Donate your block without doing any quilting. Participate in quilt as you go...any style quilting you choose. Ruler work will be demonstrated at Members Teaching Members on March 23 by Carla. There will also be workshops or smaller pod meetings depending on amount of interest.

Participate in assembling the blocks into a quilt. We will be using a Quilt As You Go technique which will be demonstrated by Venera at Members Teaching Members on March 23rd.There can be a workshop /pod meetings on this as needed.

OTHER WAYS TO PARTICIPATE

Host pod meetings in your home. You decide how many members you can comfortably seat with their sewing machines. Help will be available if needed providing electrical cords, etc.

Donate backing or batting. Share any relevant expertise as teacher or assistant at workshop or pods.
