

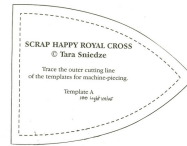
Royal Cross Quilt

Block Construction Guide

Please read these instructions *before* you begin to sew. The two minutes spent identifying fabric patches and the manner and order in which they are sewn together are far more enjoyable than five minutes spent using a seam ripper!

The kit you receive contains fabric pre-cut in the sizes needed to construct one block:

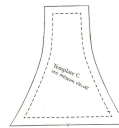
- Four (4) $2\frac{1}{2}$ inch medium-value squares
- Eight (8) $2\frac{7}{8}$ inch light-value half-square triangles
- Four (4) light-value template “A” pieces



- Four (4) dark-value template “B” pieces



- Four (4) medium-value template “C” pieces



Step 1: Corner Units *(make 4)*

Using photo 1 as a guide, take two (2) $2\frac{7}{8}$ inch light-value half-square triangles and one (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ inch medium-value square. Stitch the straight edge of one triangle to one side of the square and press the seam outwards. Then stitch the second triangle to the adjacent side triangle of the square as shown in photo 2.

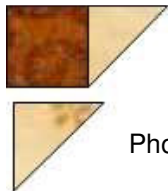

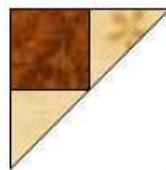

Step 2: “Trumpet” units *(make 4)*

Referring to photo 3, sew a dark-value template B piece to the widest end of a medium –value template C piece. Press the seam towards the dark side.

Step 3: Block “Spine” *(make 1)*

Sew 2 “Trumpet” units to opposite sides of a 1 1/2 inch dark-value square as shown in photo 4. Press the seams inwards.

Step 4: Side Units *(make 2)*

Sew a light-value template “A” shape to either side of a “Trumpet” unit as shown in photo 5. Press the seams outward

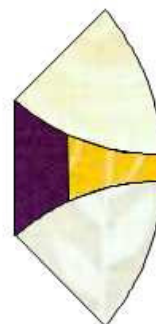

Step 5: Cross Assembly

Set the side units into either side of the block “spine”, pinning them first, matching the seamlines in the center. Sew them in place. The resulting unit is shown in Photo 6.

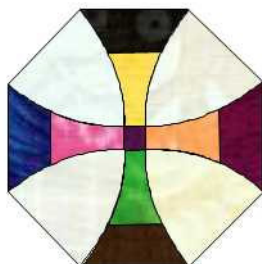

Step 6: Block Completion

Sew a corner unit to exposed edge of each shape “A” of the cross assembly as shown in Photo 7. Press the completed block lightly and enjoy the result!

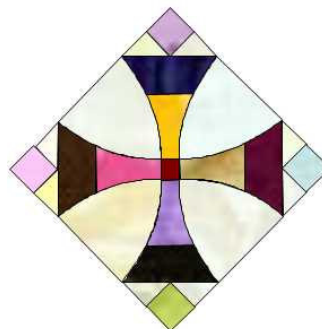
